## STCU 31st BOARD RECORD OF DECISIONS – 18 NOVEMBER 2010



The STCU Governing Board, at its 31st meeting, made the following decisions:

- ➤ Approved eight (8) regular projects (including continuations) for a total of USD \$384,102 + €316,228 (subject to funds availability).
- ➤ Approved six (6) STCU-Moldovan Academy of Sciences Targeted R&D Initiative projects for a total of USD \$124,987 + €17,740 (subject to funds availability).
- Approved six (6) STCU-Azerbaijan Academy of Sciences Targeted R&D Initiative projects for a total of USD \$299,361 (subject to funds availability).
- ➤ Approved the 2010 Administrative Operating Budget (AOB) as presented (Total=\$1,675,139), with sharing ratios for the 2011 AOB to be USA 39.23%, EU 39.57%, and Canada 21.20% (subject to funds availability).
- Approved Supplemental Budgets (SBs) as presented, with \$100,000 & €38,462 for Activity 04.01, \$13,334 & €5,128 for Activity 05.01, and \$30,000 & €11,538 for Activity 09.01, according to pledged amounts by each Funding Party, as well as \$760,000 assigned to Activities by the USA, €700,000 assigned to Activities by the EU, \$924,000 assigned to Activities by CA and \$69,543 assigned to Activities by Partners (subject to funds availability).
- ➤ Approved STCU and European Union signature of €4,000,000 project entitled, "Bio-safety and bio-security improvement at the Ukrainian anti-plague station (UAPS) in Simferopol".
- ➤ Accepted the 31 December 2009 Financial Statement Audit Report and Management Letter as presented.
- ➤ Confirmed its support for the Secretariat to make use of donated funds from the liquidated INTAS program to sponsor new opportunities for Targeted Initiative and similar program activities with the National Space Agency of Ukraine and with Kyiv Polytechnic Institute.
- Approved Lubbock Fine Chartered Accountants as auditors of the STCU financial statements for the Year Ended 31 December 2010 and the Year Ended 31 December 2011.
- ➤ Confirmed extension of current Deputy Executive Director (UA) Igor Lytvynov for a oneyear term beginning 20 November 2010, with funding provided temporarily from the STCU AOB.
